Facts about CFIDS/FMS

- ❖ 3-6 percent of the US population meet the definition for FMS
- ❖ CFS may affect as many as 4 million Americans - more than Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's, Lupus, Lung Cancer or Ovarian cancer
- ❖ Less than 20% of Americans with CFS have been diagnosed due to lack of education and awareness.
- ❖ CFS and Fibromyalgia are as debilitating as Multiple Sclerosis, Lupus, Rheumatoid arthritis and other similar chronic conditions.
- ❖ The last annual economic impact of CFS is estimated to be more than 9.1 billion
